Ureteral reconstruction can be challenging when done open or in a minimally-invasive manner. Ureteral reconstruction is a perfect use of the surgical robot. Here Andrade et al. This will add to the body of literature and video instruction that improves and propels the field of robotic/minimally-invasive urologic reconstruction.
