



Editorial Comment: Female Urethroplasty: A Critical Review of Indications, Techniques and Concerns

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COMMENT

Urethral stricture is one of the most challenging conditions in reconstructive surgery (1-4). Many techniques have been described and there is extensive experience regarding the treatment of urethral strictures in men; however, urethral strictures in women are rarer and are the subject of far fewer publications. In this paper of Chakraborty and colleagues (5) we can observe a very nice narrative review about the indications, techniques and concerns of female urethroplasty. The authors show a practical guide for urologists managing female urethral strictures, including an overview of the female urethral sphincter mechanism and the most common urethroplasty techniques. Institutional ethics board approval is not required for this review article; however, proper consent for using operative images involving human participants has been obtained from the respective patients before surgery. We congratulate the authors for the interesting paper.
